ONLY MANUFACTURED HOOP SHEDS BASED ON INDUSTRIAL STANDARDS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE BOATYARD

NO TEMPORARY TARPS OR POLY SHEETING ON LONG TERM SHEDS

HOLD DOWN METHOD – CONCRETE BLOCKS OR WATER FILLED BARRELS

UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES IS THE STRUCTURE TO BE SPIKED TO THE BLACKTOP
MAX. SHED WIDTH 20 FT. IN ACCORDANCE WITH MARINA POLICY OR WITH PRIOR WRITTEN APPROVAL OF SHELTER ISLAND MARINA MANAGEMENT.

LOCATION TO BE DESIGNATED BY MARINA

MAX. HEIGHT IN ACCORDANCE WITH B.C. HYDRO REGULATIONS

SHED AREA RENTED ON A SQ/FT BASIS (NOT BOAT LENGTH)

ADDITIONAL CHARGE FOR AREA IN FRONT OR AT REAR OF SHED (i.e. CONTAINER OR LOCKUP)

OWNER WILL KEEP SURROUNDING AREA NEAT & TIDY DURING STAY

IF IN THE INTEREST OF SHELTER ISLAND MARINA BOATYARD MANAGEMENT, OR AT THE REQUEST OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, THE STRUCTURE NEEDS TO BE MOVED, THE OWNER WILL COMPLY AT HIS/HER EXPENSE IN THE TIME FRAME STATED BY THE MARINA.
